Obituary from the Linesville Herald dated 6/21/1932

Adolphus Bullis was born in Linesville, Pa., Nov. 8, 1861, and died June 18, 1932, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. OS Bennett. He was married to Mary Glancy 50 years ago, and to this union was born six children, four of them having died in infancy. Mrs. Bennett and CA Bullis, with his widow and seven grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren remain to mourn his loss.

Mr. Bullis has been a life-long resident of Linesville and was one of it's oldest residents.

The funeral was held at the home of his daughter on Monday and was conducted by Rev. Sloan of the Methodist Church, assisted by Rev. Hartman of the Baptist Church.

Interment was in the Linesville Cemetery.

NOTE: CA Bullis would be Charles A. Bullis; Sloan would be A. Harold Sloan and Hartman would be Daniel Hartman.
