 "BULLIS - In Linesville, Sept. 12, 1900, of cholera infantum, Edith, five months old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Adolphus Bullis.
 Rev. JN Hampe, pastor of Springboro Wesleyan Methodist Church, conducted funeral servics at the house at 2 p.m. Friday. Interment in Linesville cemetery.
 We loved her, yes we loved her,
 But angels loved her more;
 And they have sweetly called her
 To younder shining shore.
 The golden gates were opened,
 A gentle voice said come
 And with farewells unspoken
 They calmly entered home."
