- 2 His obituary was published. From the Garwood Scrapbook at the Linesville Historical Society:
 Charles A. Hudson died Friday, Dec. 19th, 1902, aged 88 years, 10 months and 4 days. He lived a sailor's life for several years after leaving his parents while only a boy, during which time he sailed around the world, being employed on a whaling vessel.
 Deceased married for third wife, Mrs. Susan A. Bunnell, on July 24th, 1892, and although in poor health he lived to enjoy many blessings meted out to him in his old age. He was of an unusual hopeful disposition and a man whom everybody respected on account of his gentility and true openheartedness, being a most charitable person, and except for his love of giving might have died a rich man. He enlisted at the breaking out of the Civil war and fought bravely for his country until peace was declared. He had been a member of Jamestown Baptist Church for many years.
 Funeral was conducted from Linesville Baptist church on Sunday, Dec. 21, in charge of Linesville GAR Post. Rev. Plannett delivered the funeral sermon and made some excellent remarks on the life of his old comrade, after which remains were laid in the cemetery at this place.
