- Her obituary was published. Clipping from the Garwood Scrapbook D:  
 Louisa, wife of JG Gaugh, died of paralysis, at her home, August 23, 1895, in the 72d year of her age. For over a year she had been a sick woman, the last weeks of her suffering being intense. Besides her husband her daughter, Mrs. OH Cram, survives her. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon, Rev. Washburn officiating, she being a member of Linesville Universalist Church. During her long life of health, she was known by her sympathetic disposition and ever ready to lend a hand to a friend in need.
