- Her obituary was published February 8, 1898 in Linesville Borough, Crawford County, PA. From the Linesville Herald, page 7, column 3:
 Mrs. Prouty was born in Linesville, Nov. 1st, 1844, and departed this life Sabbath morning, Feb. 6th, 1898, at 9:45 o'clock. She had been a long a patient sufferer from asthma and lung trouble. She knew how to bear the burdens of life, and she taught her friends that she knew how to suffer. She was married to Edward Prouty, May 1st, 1870. Jan. 31st, 1897, she closed with the Gospel offer and united with the United Presbyterian church of this place. She has ever since leaned on the everlasting arm and died with the 23d Psalm in her mind. Peacefully and quietly she passed away, saying: "I Want to go Home." She leaves a father, mother, brother, sister and two children, Mrs. Cyrus Baldwin and Ellery Whaley, besides her husband. The funeral was held in the church on Tuesday afternoon, the pastor officiating.
