- His obituary was published in the Linesville Herald October 7, 1908 in Linesville Borough, Crawford County, PA.
 Alonzo Smith died October 5, 1908, at 6 o'clock p.m. The funeral will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock at his late residence in Linesville. Deceased was born in Rochester, NY, July 31, 1819. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Gabriel Smith, moved to South Shenango in 1884, and after nine years' residence, located at Townville where the subject of this sketch helped to clear the land of timber. In 1847 Alonzo Smith and Miss Eunice Cordelia Bly were married and the next year moved to a farm at Espyville, residing there until 1864, when they purchased the farm in Conneaut township, In 1903 he moved to Linesville. One son, George, survives him, and two brothers. In his father's family were nine children, our townsman being the oldest; Louis Smith, of Wisconsin, now living, being the youngest. Mr. Smith was a very industrious man and labored faithfully at his work until 80 years of age when his strength began to fail him, while death was the result of a succession of paralytic strokes, the last coming on October 1 and lasting until his death all his long life he passed without any organic disease coming upon him. His family, surrounded by a sympathizing friends, mourn his loss, and he will be missed by all who knew him. Rev. Geo B. Carr conducts funeral services.
