- His obituary was published October 9, 1952 in Linesville Borough, Crawford County, PA. From the Linesville Herald, page 1, column 3:  
**ERNEST H. COLLINS DIES**  
 Ernest H. Collins, former Linesville banker and president of the Borough Council, died at City Hospital, Meadville, Tuesday morning. He was 91.  
 Mr. Collins retired 30 years ago after serving many years as cashier of the Linesville State Bank. He was a member of the Linesville Methodist Church, treasurer for many years.  
 He was born in Espyville, the son of the late Robert B. and Lucy Waters Collins. He lived in Crawford County all of his life.  
 His wife, Bertha M. Collins, died in 1950.  
 Both were very interested in music and both instructors at one time.  
 Surviving are several nieces and nephews.  
 Friends may call at the Maryott Funeral Home, Linesville, after 7 p.m. (Wednesday). Services will be held at the funeral home Friday at 2:30 p.m. Interment will be at Linesville Cemetery.

 Services in memory of Ernest H. Collins were held Friday afternoon at the Maryott Funeral Home, Linesville. The Rev. WH Sloan, pastor of the Asbury Park (NJ) Methodist Church, officiated. He was assisted by the Rev. RS Naylor, pastor of the Linesville Methodist Church.
