- Her obituary was published. Per the Paul Henry Scrapbook at the Linesville Historical Society, page 14, column 4:  
  

"Ella A., wife of T. Clemson Frey, died at her home, Conneaut township, Wednesday morning, July 14, 1897, at 3:30 o'clock. She was a daughter of Ezra and Lydia Scovel, her mother having died seven years ago, and a sister of D.M. Scovel and Mrs. R.B. Oswald, of this place.

She was born in Rossville, Iowa, and was 43 years and 8 days of age. She was married at Shermansville, 25 years ago. Mrs. Frey had been in poor health for several years prior to her death, and although of a cheerful disposition at all times, had been a great sufferer.

She experienced religion and united with the ME Church when quite young, and was always a devoted and sincere Christian. She had been a member of the church choir, an earnest worker in the Sunday school, was prominent in social gatherings, and a friend to all.

But a few hours before death relieved her suffering, she asked those with her to sing, naming "Sweet hour of Prayer" as her choice. She then called for prayer, and while her friends prayed, she also prayed that Jesus would take her home. She then called the family and said she was ready to go.

Mrs. Frey will be greatly missed by her many friends, and a sad home will be left to her husband, son George and daughter, Mary Belle, who have the heartfelt sympathy of all. Her funeral was held from the Frey church at 2:00 p.m. Friday, services being conducted by her former ppastor, Rev. J.D. Clemmons, assisted by Rev. G.H. Stuntz. Her body was interred in the cemetery at this place, according to her request."
