- He was educated in 1879. Jefferson Medical College, Philadelphia, PA
- He was employed. From the Linesville Herald, May 19, 1886, page 2, column 2:  
Dr. J.N. Walker has purchased Dr. N.B. Naramore's house and lot in this place; possession will be given the first of August. Dr. Naramore will be here as usual the last half of each month. In the fall he will make it his home at Conneautville. The sale of property was made some time ago, but was not announced then, for reasons known to the parties themselves.
- Residences: From the Linesville Herald, August 4, 1886, page 3, column 2:  
Dr. J. N. Walker is making arrangements for the construction of a new house on the lot recently purchased of Dr. M. B. Naramore. Dr. Naramore has vacated the property.
- His obituary was published. From the Garwood Scrapbook at the Linesville Historical Society:  
**DR. J.N. WALKER**  
Dr. J.N. Walker, for over 40 years a practicing physician in Linesville, passed away at his home here about eight o'clock Monday morning, after a lingering illness. He is survived by his wife and three children, Dr. HH Walker, Linesville; Mrs. VW Graham, Corry, and Mrs. Vertner McQuiston, Atlantic. Four grandchildren also survive.  
Dr. Walker was born near Kennard, Mercer County, on Feb. 11, 1849. He graduated from Jefferson Medical College, Philadelphia, in the class of 1879 and located in Linesville in 1883. On Jan. 10, 1884, he was married to Mollie Hervey, daughter of the late Rev. HH Hervey of Hartstown. He was an elder in the UP church. He was a member of Pine Lodge 498, F&AM of Linesville, and of Sharon commandery Knights Templar.  
Funeral services in his memory will be conducted by Rev. Dr. JW Harsha, from the United Presbyterian Church in Linesville, Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment in Linesville cemetery.
