GEO. P. WHITE
 George P. White, who has been a much respected and beloved citizen of Linesville for many years, passed away quietly and peacefully on Monday, March 8th, at his home on Mercer street, after ailing for a number of years past.
 He was born at Plainfield, Vt., Oct. 31, 1839 of American-born parents, Thaddeus and Meranda White, who removed to Wolcott, Vt., in 1849.
 He enlisted with (missing) Vt. Vols., Sept. 2, 1864, and discharged Nov. 3, 1862; enlisted in No. 1 Co. of Frontier cavalry, Jan. 1, 1865, and was discharged at close of war. He was married to Mary B. Carrier, in Aug. 1867, who died Oct. 1868. On Jan. 29, 1870, he married Nancy D. Thayer of Linesville, and removed from Vermont to Pine township, in 1879, where he has lived most of the time since.
 He has held nearly every office in the gift of his township, and has been justice of the peace since 1896, except four years spent in Ohio.
 One sister, Mrs. Hattie E. Camp, of Morrisville, Vt., with his wife, survive him.
 Mr. White ws a Mason, a member of the Universalist Church, and of the G.A.R. Mr. White was a friend of Humanity and a man with a clean brain and a big heart.
 The funeral will be conducted at the Universalist church on Wednesday, at 2 p.m., by Rev. J.V. Laughland.
