- 1 His obituary was published. Clipping from the Garwood Scrapbook A:  
**OBITUARY**  
 S.C. Stratton was born in Bangor, Me., on the 28th day of October, 1814. Soon after his parents moved to Massachusetts. When but a lad he was put out to make his own living. When he was 17 years old he came to western Pennsylvania with his mother and older brothers, settling at Conneaut Lake. This was in 1831. After remaining here a few years, he came to Linesville in 1837 and engaged in business for himself. In 1839 he was married to Miss Malvina Strong. One son, Walter, blessed this union, the mother passing away soon after his birth, little Walter following at the age of three years.  
 Mr. Stratton was married March 1, 1846, to Miss Almira Van Winkle, daughter of Thomas and Nancy Van Winkle. For more than 60 years they walked life's pathway together, and there were born to them four sons, Ira, George and Thomas and Isaac, all of whom, with their mother, still survive the husband and father. All of these 60 years and more he was closely identified with business interests of Linesville and always interested in it's highest welfare. Mr. Stratton was by faith a Universalist, a member of the Church of the Good Shepherd of Linesville of which he was a liberal supporter. His body was laid to rest Tuesday, September 25, 1906, in the family lot in the Linesville Cemtery. Rev. GW Sias conducted funeral services at 2:30 Tuesday. Deceased departed this life at 2 o'clock am Sept. 23, 1906.
