From the Linesville Herald, June 16, 1886, page 2, column 4: I have been practicing medicine nearly forty-two years and am anxious to retire from the business as soon as I can get a thoroughly educated Homeopathic physician to take my place, as such a physician is very much needed in Linesville. I can furnish office and dwelling. Such a physician will do a good business from the start. Any inquiries, by mail or otherwise, will be promptly answered. L. S. 2	<p>His obituary was published. From the Garwood Scrapbook at the Linesville Historical Society: At his home in Linesville, Tuesday, May 3, 1904, Dr. LS Tyler passed to the higher life. Dr. Taylor was born in Chauauqua, NY, April 17, 1820. He was one of a family of 10 children, only one of which, Mrs. Mackey, of this place, still survives. After taking his medical degree he practiced his profession a short time in Conneautville and Conneaut Center, moving to Linesville in 1850, where he has resided ever since. He was married May 4, 1850, to Miss Mariett McGuire. Of this union two children were born, Mariett Tyler-Stratton and Byron Dewitt Tyler. He was a Spiritualist in belief. The funeral services were conducted at the house, Friday, May 6 at 2 p.m. by the Universalist minister, Rev. LL Lewis. Interment in Linesville cemetery. He has acted well his part during a long and useful life, and he leaves it full of years for a larger life beyond.</p>
